### RULES AND INFORMATION

#### **PROM DATE & TIME:**

**Date of prom: Saturday, March 28, 2015**

Prom will be held at Boudreaux's in Baton Rouge (2647 Government St.) Prom will begin at 9:00 pm and end at 12:00 am. **YOUR RIDE MUST PICK YOU UP AT THIS TIME AND NO LATER!** Do not arrive early to take pictures. If you would like to take pictures early, Rip's photography usually takes pictures at his studio on the day of prom. Call to make an appointment. We will have a photographer at prom (Michael's Photography.) **ONCE YOU LEAVE PROM, YOU MAY NOT RETURN!**

**FEES: \$65.00** (pays for Junior and Senior Years)

**\* IF YOU DO NOT PAY YOUR FEE, YOU WILL NOT ATTEND PROM. All fees must be paid by March 13th 2015.**

**\*If you are suspended through Friday March 27th you will not attend prom!**

**\*\*\*\*\*Prom fees will not be reimbursed for any reason\*\*\*\*\***

**Fee Information:** Every junior and senior that attends Zachary High School and goes to prom **MUST** pay a fee.

All juniors planning to attend prom must pay a fee. If you did not attend prom as a junior, you **MUST** pay your fee as a senior. You do not need a receipt or ticket to get in. We have your name on a list (with receipt books). If you bring a date from another school or an underclassman as your date, **they do not** pay, but you do.

Fees will be collected in the front office **only**, beginning on **Jan. 13th and ending on MARCH 13th!!!** The fee is \$65.00. If you pay your fee before Jan 23<sup>rd</sup>, you will save \$5.00. Fee goes back up to \$65 on January 26th. **YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED OR ENCOURAGED TO PAY YOUR DATE'S FEE (if they are a ZHS student.) Prom fees will not be reimbursed for ANY reason!**

#### **YOUR DATE:**

You may bring a student from another school as your date. They do not have to pay to get in. You may bring a freshman or sophomore **DATE** from ZHS, they do not have to pay. Only juniors and seniors from ZHS have to pay a fee. Remember....This is a FEE not a ticket.

IF YOUR DATE GOES TO ANOTHER SCHOOL, A VISITOR/GUEST PERMISSION FORM MUST BE COMPLETED AND TURNED IN BY **MARCH 13<sup>th</sup>**.

#### **T-SHIRT**

The prom shirt is \$15.00. You will pay for it in the front office. **It is separate from your prom fee.** You may wear your shirt to school on the Friday before prom. **Orders are due March 6<sup>th</sup>!!!**

#### **THEME- “Unmask the Night” (an elegant masquerade theme)**

**Colors- blues, black, metallic gold**

**FAVORS** All juniors and seniors that paid a fee will receive prom favors. You will pick them up the week of prom **on lunch shifts only**. This is the **ONLY** time you can pick them up. You may not ask any of the prom committee members to give them to you early. Seniors will pick up on **Monday and Tuesday**, and juniors on **Wednesday and Thursday**.

If you break or lose your favors, you will not get an extra unless there is extra after all have been distributed.

## **PROM ATTIRE (you do not have to dress for the theme of prom, that is optional)**

**\*\* Boys must wear a dark suit, dark dress pants and a coat OR a tuxedo (tuxedo colors are not limited but MUST be appropriate for a formal occasion, you **may** wear a white tuxedo or other appropriate color.)**

**\*\*Girls must wear a formal or semi-formal dress. No dress showing the waist or midriff will be acceptable. Any girl wearing such attire will be asked to leave. CHECK AHEAD OF TIME IF YOU ARE UNSURE!!!**

Boys may only wear dress shoes.

**\*\*ABSOLUTLEY NO SUNGLASSES** will be worn inside of the location where prom is being held.

**\*\*Boys may not wear earrings OR ANY FACIAL PIERCINGS. This includes non Zachary High School students.**

Remember, this is a formal occasion.

\*If you are in doubt as to whether an item of clothing will be allowed, do not wear it. Chaperones at the door and in the building will ask you to leave if your attire or your date's attire does not meet the requirements. The chaperone's decision is final. Again remember THIS IS A FORMAL EVENT!!!

**\*YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS OR ALCOHOL.** These will not be allowed on the premises of Boudreaux's. You will be arrested and suspended or expelled if either is found on your person or in your vehicle. **SEVERAL Baton Rouge Police and Zachary Police officers will both be on duty at prom as well as the ZHS administration and faculty. ALL ZHS RULES APPLY.**

### **Prom Transportation 2015**

As you begin thinking about and making plans for the prom this year please be aware of some new stipulations that will be in place. With school rules and safety in mind we **are not going to allow students to ride party buses or any similar type vehicles to the prom.** In addition, if you choose to use a limousine to get to and from the prom, there will be a letter that will have to be filled out by the limousine company and driver that indicates you are not to use drugs or alcohol while in the vehicle. That note will also be signed by all riding in the limousine and their parents. All students who do not drive, will also have to be dropped off on the premises of Boudreaux's and not somewhere else in the area. You will be refused admittance if you choose to do otherwise.

Traditionally, alcohol and/or drugs are often involved in prom planning no matter what school is having the prom. Our goal is to exclude it from the Zachary High School prom, so we hope you understand and are willing to cooperate so that this year's prom is the best ever.
