8. Jostens will be here **Tuesday, March 27th**, in the Visual Performing Arts Center during both lunch shifts to distribute senior supplies (including cap & gown). There will be about 6 weeks between receiving your cap and gown and the actual graduation ceremony. It is your responsibility to keep your cap and gown safe and clean.

9. **Graduation tickets** will be available for pick up in the Counseling Office starting **Monday, April 30th**. Only the student or parent will be allowed to pick up and sign for the tickets. Each graduate will receive 20 tickets, and they are printed on heat sensitive security paper to avoid duplication. All **fees** must be cleared, and the **LOSFA consent form** must be on file in the Counseling Office. The **FAFSA** must be completed before graduation tickets will be issued.
10. Seniors' Honors Night will be **Tuesday, May 15th, at 6:30 p.m.** in the ZHS gymnasium. All senior awards and scholarships will be presented at this time. Any scholarships that need to be announced will need to be submitted to Mrs. Walters in the Counseling Office by **Friday, April 20th**.
11. Graduation practice will be held in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center on **Thursday, May 17th, at 10:00 a.m.** Practice will last approximately 2 ½ hours. Roll will be taken at practice. **Attendance is required for participation in the ceremony.** Tardiness will not be tolerated.
12. Graduation will be **Thursday, May 17th, at 6:30 p.m.** at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center, North Stadium Road, Baton Rouge, LA. Graduates are **required to arrive one hour before the time of graduation (5:30 p.m.)** at the PMAC.

 - Letter(s) of recommendation (if required)
- The blank application is on the Senior Class moodle page as well. This application must be typed and will be used for all scholarships **except numbers 5, 9, 12, 14*, 15, 16 and 19**. The applications for these scholarships are attached to the scholarship itself. Number **14** must be submitted online only at www.braf.org, Scholarships, Jerry Boudreaux Scholarship.
- The deadline for turning in all scholarship applications is **Thursday, March 29th**.
- You will find out if you were awarded a scholarship at Seniors’ Honors Night, **May 15th**.
