1. Every senior participating in the graduation ceremony must purchase a cap and gown packet from Jostens. No student can borrow a cap and gown from previous graduates. If you have **not** purchased a cap and gown packet, please see Mrs. Walters in the Counseling Office ASAP.
2. Completed senior service hour forms will be collected in the Counseling Office **April 15th – May 3rd**. Make sure your first and last name is on the form.
3. Money owed list and outstanding fees are due by **Thursday, April 18th**. This includes the \$50 senior fee.
4. Textbooks and laptops must be returned to the library **Tuesday, April 30th**.
5. All seniors enrolled in a LEAP2025/EOC course need to ensure their test date with their teachers. Students taking a makeup LEAP2025/EOC test need to be aware of the test date and be present. Students must take makeup assessment in order to meet graduation requirements. Any questions, please contact the Counseling Office.
6. **Graduation tickets** will be available for pick up in the Counseling Office starting **Tuesday, April 30th**. Only the student or parent will be allowed to pick up and sign for the tickets. Each graduate will receive 20 tickets, and they are printed on heat sensitive security paper to avoid duplication. All **fees** must be cleared, and the **LOSFA consent form** must be on file in the Counseling Office. The **FAFSA** must be completed before graduation tickets will be issued.
7. Seniors' Honors Night will be **Tuesday, May 14th, at 6:30 p.m.** in the ZHS gymnasium. All senior awards and scholarships will be presented at this time. Dress is church attire. Any scholarships that need to be announced should be submitted to Mrs. Walters in the Counseling Office by **Friday, March 29th**.
8. Graduation practice will be held **Thursday, May 16th, at 9:00 a.m.** Please note, practice will last approximately 2 ½ hours and roll will be taken. **Attendance is required for participation in the ceremony.** Tardiness will not be tolerated.
9. Uniforms are not required for graduation practice; however, you should be dressed appropriately. This means **NO shorts, tank shirts, or midriiffs showing.**
10. No outside graduation regalia is allowed. Honor stoles and cords will be distributed at the Seniors' Honors Ceremony to students that meet the required criteria.
11. Graduation will be **Thursday, May 16th, at 6:30 p.m.** at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center, North Stadium Road, Baton Rouge, LA. Graduates are **required to arrive one hour before the time of graduation (5:30 p.m.)** at the PMAC.
12. Improper behavior will not be tolerated. This applies to practice as well as to your behavior now until May 16th, both on and off campus. Violations eliminate a student from participation in the actual ceremony and may halt the processing of the diploma.
13. It is advisable to dress in the cap and gown at home. The tassel should be on your LEFT Side. Pin caps on. Students are **NOT** allowed to decorate graduation caps.
14. During the ceremony there will be no place to store personal items. Please leave purses, grooming items, etc. with family and friends.

15. Dress regulations for the Graduation Ceremony:
- Males: Solid color dress pants; dress shoes; ties and white or light-colored collared shirt. Hair grooming/style should be according to school policy. No earrings or nose rings; must be clean shaven**
- Females: Light colored or white dress; dress shoes that are comfortable and ones you can walk in (NO flip flops, cowboy boots); no nose rings**
- *Appropriate graduation attire will be determined by ZHS administration.**
16. Any student that appears to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
17. Cameras will not be allowed near the stage during graduation. A professional photographer will take each graduate's picture as he/she receives the diploma. Information concerning price, etc., will be distributed at practice.
18. High School Graduation is a once-in-a-lifetime event to be respected and treated with dignity. Please be courteous to all graduates and their family members in attendance throughout the ceremony by refraining from excessive noise and loud talking/cheering. Balloons, posters, flowers, air horns, cowbells or any other noise-makers are not allowed at the graduation ceremony.
