- 1. All senior service hours <u>must</u> be completed and turned in to the Counseling office by **April 30**th.
- 2. Complete the scholarships awarded form and return to Mrs. Beadle in the counseling office by May 6th if it is to be announced at graduation.
- 3. Money owed list and outstanding cafeteria fees are due by **Thursday**, **April 23**rd. This includes the \$40 senior fee owed to Zachary High.
- 4. Textbooks and laptops returned April 28th.
- 5. Senior Exam Schedule:

- 7. No senior will be permitted on campus after his or her last exam without pre-approved school business and in **school uniform**. You <u>must</u> check-in with the front office.
- 8. **Graduation tickets** will be available for pick up in the Counseling Office starting **Thursday, April 30**th. Only the student or parent will be allowed to pick up and sign for the tickets. Each graduate will receive 10 tickets and they are printed on heat sensitive security paper to avoid duplication.
- 9. Balloons, flowers, air horns, cowbells, or any other noise-makers are not allowed in the church.

- 10. Graduation practice will be held at the Bethany World Prayer Center on Tuesday, May 19th at 1:00 p.m. Practice will last approximately 2 ½ hours. Roll will be taken at practice. Attendance is required for participation in the ceremony. Only excuses from doctors will be accepted. Tardiness will not be tolerated.
- 11. Uniforms are not required for graduation practice; however you should be dressed appropriately. This means **NO shorts, tank shirts, or midriffs showing.** We will be in a place of worship, so be respectful.
- 12. Alcohol, or the smell of it, automatically eliminates a student from participation in graduation.
- 13. Caps and gowns will be issued at the end of practice on **May 19th**. Caps and gowns are yours to keep.
- 14. Graduation will be **Tuesday, May 19th, at 6:30 p.m.** at the Bethany World Prayer Center, 13855 Plank Road, Baker, LA. Graduates are **required to arrive forty-five minutes before the time of graduation (5:45 p.m.)** at Bethany World Prayer Center. Report to the school auditorium directly behind the main center. It is requested that guests arrive no later than 6:15 p.m.
- 15. Unbecoming behavior will not be tolerated. This applies to practice as well as to your behavior now until May 19th, both on and off campus. Violations eliminate a candidate from participation in the actual ceremony and may halt the processing of the diploma.
- 16. It is advisable to dress in the cap and gown at home. The tassel should be on your LEFT SIDE. Pin caps on, especially if it is windy.
- 17. Cameras will not be allowed near the stage during graduation. A professional photographer will take each graduate's picture as he/she receives the diploma and/or special award(s). Information concerning price, etc., will be distributed at practice. If your parents would like to take pictures before the ceremony you need to be there by 5:30 p.m.
- 18. Dress regulations are as follows:

Males: Solid color dress pants; dress shoes; long ties and light colored or white collared shirt. Hair grooming/style should be according to school policy.

Females: Light or white dress – no collar or flat collar; hairstyle on which your cap will fit. Dress shoes - recommended black, white, cream or beige. (NO flip flops, cowboy boots)
*Appropriate graduation attire will be determined by ZHS administration.
